Village of Canisteo Supports Smoke-Free and Tobacco-Free Public Spaces



In October 2021, the Village of Canisteo passed a local law banning smoking, vaping, cannabis use, and all other tobacco use in municipal parks, buildings, and at bus stops.

Municipal buildings include the Village Hall, Department of Public Works, Water Treatment Department, and Fire/Police Department. Bus stops include school and HAT bus stops. Municipal parks include Nicholas F. Clark Memorial Park and the Bandstand/Parking Lot.

The Village of Canisteo partnered with the Southern Tier Tobacco Awareness Coalition (STTAC) to create signage to raise awareness of the importance of keeping these public spaces safe, clean and smoke-free.
